

Consent & Release Agreement

Part 1: Student Acknowledgement and Release

I have read the (condensed) NCASA Student Eligibility rules provided with this "Consent & Release Agreement" and know of no reason why I am not eligible to represent my school in interscholastic academic competition. If accepted as a representative, I agree to follow the rules of my school and NCASA and to abide by their decisions. I know that participation is a privilege. I understand that participation may necessitate an early dismissal from classes.

I voluntarily accept any and all responsibility for my own safety and welfare while I participate in scholastic competition. With full understanding of the risks involved, I release and hold harmless my school, the schools against which it competes, the school district, the contest officials, and NCASA of any and all responsibility and liability for any injury or claim resulting from such participation and agree to take no legal action against NCASA because of any accident or mishap involving my participation.

Should I be 18 years of age or older, or should I be emancipated from my parent(s)/guardian(s):

I hereby authorize the use or disclosure of my individually identifiable health information should treatment for illness or injury become necessary. I consent to the disclosure, by my school, to the NCASA, upon its request, of all records relevant to my academic eligibility including, but not limited to, my records relating to enrollment and attendance, academic standing, age, discipline and residence. I hereby grant the released parties the right to photograph and/or videotape me and further to use my name, face, likeness, voice, and appearance in connection with exhibitions, publicity, advertising, promotional, and commercial materials without reservation or limitation. The released parties, however, are under no obligation to exercise said rights herein.

I understand that the authorizations and rights granted herein are voluntary and that I may revoke any or all of them at any time by submitting said revocation in writing to my school. By doing so, however, I understand that I will no longer be eligible for participation in interscholastic competitions through NCASA. 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Student Eligibility

- A. An individual is eligible to participate in a NCASA Competition as a representative of a Member School if that individual:
 - 1. is not a high school graduate, and
 - 2. is a full time student in the Member School the student represents, and
 - 3. has been in regular attendance at the participant school since the tenth day of class of the present school year, OR has been enrolled and in regular attendance for fifteen (15) or more calendar days before the Competition, and
 - 4. has a signed NCASA release form on file, and
 - 5. was not recruited, including
 - a. encouraging a student in any way to change schools for the primary purpose of participating in NCASA activities or
 - b. offering to the student or the student's family, including
 - i. cash,
 - ii. waiver of tuition,
 - iii. board,
 - iv. lodging,
 - v. transportation,
 - vi. promise of better conditions at the Member School,
 - vii. promise of better conditions on a Member School Team,
 - viii. employment or contractual relationship, or
 - ix. tangible or intangible property or services.
- B. A student shall not represent more than one school in an activity in the same school year.
